

MeadowBrook Monday Evening Golf League

Scoring

Partners will play 9 hole matches scored as follows:

- 1 point for individual low net score per hole
- 1 point for total team net score per hole
- 3 points per match for low team net score
(points for all the above will be split when ties occur)
- 21 total points per match

FULL HANDICAP will be used for each match.

Each player is responsible for posting their score (EQUITABLE stroke control will be used when posting scores) **at the end of each round.**

In order to have a valid handicap, scores for all rounds of golf played should be posted in the computer. Be sure to include the course slope and rating (follow all instructions on the computer screen).

If only one partner is able to play and no substitutes are available, the lone player's net score per hole is doubled. The total team points cannot exceed 18. A single team player cannot win the 3 match points for low team net score unless playing against another single team player.

Makeup Matches: If a team cannot play a particular Monday match they can play a makeup round anytime between the Tuesday before the missing Monday and up to the Thursday after the missing Monday. The team that can not make the regularly schedule Monday match, **MUST** notify the team they intend to play a makeup round. When playing a makeup match, turn the complete score card in at the front counter. The score card will then be matched with your opponent's scorecard.

Both teams could pick a day to makeup the match. It must be played in the same timeframe noted above (between the Tuesday before the missed Monday and up to the Thursday after the missed Monday). All match points will be scored as normal — including the team total points.

The goal is not to increase the number of teams that do not play on Monday night but to reduce the number of forfeits. When playing makeup matches the green fees will not be league rates — the prevailing green fees on date of play will be charged.

Forfeits: If a team cannot play a match and cannot makeup the match they will forfeit the match. The forfeiting team gets 0 (zero) match points. The team that receives the benefit of the forfeit gets 15 match points. The benefiting team only gets the 15 match points if they play as scheduled on Monday night. If both teams do not play, both teams get 0 (zero) match points.

How to score a match.....

1. List all players and full handicaps on the card. Example follows:
 Team #1 Player A - 13 Team #2 Player Y - 11
 Player B - 6 Player Z - 19
2. All matches are played off the lowest handicap player. To determine how many strokes each player gets for the match, first determine which player is the lowest handicap (in our example it is Player B) – that player gets **NO** strokes. Next deduct the lowest handicap from each of the other players handicaps to determine each players total match strokes.
 Team #1 Player A gets 7 strokes (13-6)
 Player B get 0 strokes
 Team #2 Player Y gets 5 strokes (11-6)
 Player Z gets 13 strokes (19-6)
3. The actual strokes for each player are given on each hole beginning with the hardest rated hole (for Meadowbrook that is hole #8) and ending when the match strokes have been exhausted. If the match strokes exceed 9, the tenth and subsequent strokes again begin with the hardest rated hole (thus the player gets two strokes on that hole) and continues till the match strokes are exhausted. In the example – the x identifies strokes.

4. There are two match points per hole (both based on scores AFTER strokes).
 The first is for the lowest net score by a team – if there is a tie each team gets ½ point.
 The second is for lowest net total score by a team – if there is a tie each team gets ½ point.
 In our example: for the first hole Team #2 gets low score (player Z, 4 minus the stroke = 3) and Team #2 gets low total team (8 – 1 = 7) for two match points; for the second hole Team #2 gets low score (player Y with a 3) and the teams split low total (Team #1 is 10-1 stroke = 9 & Team #2 is 10-1 stroke = 9) thus Team #1 gets ½ match points and Team #2 gets 1 ½ match points;.....
 Continue on to verify the rest.....note the total for each team at the end.
5. Finally, there are three additional match points for total net scores (actual scores less handicaps). Team #1 has a total low net of 71 (48+42 = 90 less 19 handicap strokes) and Team #2 has a total low net of 72 (45+57 = 102 less 30 handicap strokes). Thus team #1 gets 3 match points for total low net. Again if this was a tie, each team would get 1 ½ points.
6. The final match score is Team #1 gets 11 match points (8 + 3) and Team #2 gets 10 match points (10 + 0).
